RECIPES

APPLE CAKE RECIPE

9 oz SR Flour
Pinch Salt
6 oz Margarine
4 oz Caster Sugar
4 oz Sultanas
12 oz Apples (when diced and cored)
2 Eggs

Mix everything together, adding Eggs last. Stir together, do not beat. Pour into lined tin. Bake at 180 deg C for 50 mins, Sprinkle with caster sugar when cooked.

FADGE RECIPE

Ingredients: 1lb SR Flour
1 oz Margarine
½ teaspoon Salt
1 dip of knife into Syrup tin
300 mls Buttermilk
1 tablespoon Milk

Method: Heat oven to 190 deg C.
Add all ingredients to a bowl and mix well together. Roll into a round and slice mark the top. Place on a tray and bake for 45 minutes.



REGULATIONS

6. **Exhibits will be received at the Bake & Create Show between 9.00am and 11.00am on Friday 24th July. (The entry gate will be closed to all traffic from 11.00am).**
7. Judging will commence at 11.00 a.m. on Friday.
8. The Bake & Create Show will be open to the public on Friday afternoon from approx 2.30 p.m. to 5.30 p.m., and on Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. The Exhibits, will be kept in safety overnight. **Trophies will be presented at 4.30 p.m. on Saturday, exhibits can be removed immediately afterwards. No entry for cars before 5.30 p.m. All exhibits unclaimed by 6.00 p.m. will be disposed of to Charities.**
9. The following Prize tickets will be awarded in each class - 1st, 2nd, 3rd. Highly Commended will be awarded in classes with 12 or more entries. Children's classes at Judges discretion.
10. Prize winners will receive their prize money at the entrance to the Bake & Create Show on Saturday.
11. Judges' decisions will be final.
12. In the case of a tie for the Cup Winner in any Section, the Cup will be awarded to the competitor with highest awards.
13. Exhibitors who have 12 or more entries will receive a Free Pass to the Showground on Saturday 25th July.
