## MARMALADE CAKE

| 225 g Plain Flour | Zest of 1 orange and 1 Lemon |
| :--- | :--- |
| 15 g Baking Powder | 150 ml Milk |
| 125 g Dark Soft Brown Sugar | 1 Teaspoon White Wine Vinegar |
| 125 g Unsalted Butter | 1 large Tablespoon Marmalade |
| 1 teaspoon Ground Mixed Spice | 1 Tablespoon Demerara Sugar |
| 125 g Dried Mixed Fruit |  |

Pre-heat non fan oven 180oc. Grease and line a $7^{\prime \prime}$ round cake tin. Mix flour, baking powder and sugar together in large mixing bowl. Add the butter and rub through your fingers until mixture resembles breadcrumbs. Add mixed spice, mixed fruit and zest and mix together. Add the milk, a little at a time, and mix well. Add white wine vinegar and marmalade and mix well. Spoon mixture into prepared cake tin and flatten with the back of a spoon. Sprinkle demerara sugar onto mixture. Bake in the centre of a preheated oven for $11 / 2$ hours or until firm to touch. Cool cake in tin before transferring to a wire rack.

6. Labels will be issued to attach to exhibits. Please ensure that jam and handicraft labels are securely tied or fixed on.
7. Exhibits will be received at the Bake and Create Section (Thorburn Building behind main hall) Between 9am and 10am on Friday 26th July (The green gate will be closed to all traffic from 10am)
8. Judging will commence at 10.30am on Friday
9. The hall will be open to the public on Friday afternoon Approx. 1.30pm to 5.30 pm , and on Saturday from 9am till 4.30 pm . The exhibits will be kept in safety overnight. Trophies will be presented at 4.30pm on Saturday, exhibits can be removed immediately afterwards. No entry for cars before 5.30 pm. All Exhibits unclaimed by 6.00 pm will be disposed of to charities
10. The following prizes will be awarded in each class-1st, 2nd, 3rd. Highly Commended will be awarded in classes with 12 or more entries. Children's classes at judges discretion.
11. Judges decision is final.
12. In the case of a tie for the Cup Winner in any section, the cup will be awarded to the competitor with the highest awards.
13. Exhibitors who have 12 or more entries will receive a free pass to the showground on Saturday 27th July
